3. **LAFD Brush Clearance Update:** It's brush clearance season, and all properties within the City of L.A. need to have their brush cleared this month. If you have questions, this is a terrific time to raise them. Brush clearance plays a significant role in reducing the threat from wildfire.
4. **Tips and Financial Opportunities for Home Hardening:** We like to call home hardening "Wildfire retrofitting," and regardless of the term, it can be taxing for a homeowner to move forward without knowing the costs involved, as well as options for having someone else pay for the project. We'll cover "low cost" retrofitting, as well as how to apply for grants.
5. **Insurance Update:** MySafe:LA will provide an update on the most recent changes in the insurance landscape in California, and will highlight the Insurance Institute for Business & Home Safety's "Living With Wildfire" program - ideal for unaffiliated homeowners.
6. **Wildfire History:** The Canyon 2 Fire (OCT 2017). A rapidly moving wildfire that burned in the Anahiem Hills area of Orange County. More than 16,000 people had to evacuate. More than 9,000 acres burned, 25 homes were destroyed and more than 55 damaged.
