2. **WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE AN EVACUATION:** David Barrett, Executive Director of MySafe:LA, will lead an online presentation on the often-overlooked realities of wildfire evacuation preparation. Most people underestimate what is truly relevant when getting ready to leave, and David will share the essential facts that everyone living in high fire zones needs to know. Drawing on more than two decades of experience with wildfire response and evacuation planning, he will outline how to prepare effectively—from assembling the right go-bag to making family and community readiness plans. David brings a unique blend of frontline insight and community-focused guidance to help residents take the proper steps before an evacuation order is ever issued.
3. **HOW EVACUATIONS WORK, WITH LAFD DEPUTY CHIEF JAIME MOORE:** Deputy Chief Jaime Moore, commander of the Los Angeles City Fire Department's Operations Valley Bureau, will lead an online presentation on wildfire evacuations, drawing on his extensive experience managing complex incidents across the city. In this session, he will explain the essential facts every resident should know about how evacuations work and outline the responsibilities of the various agencies involved—from fire suppression and law enforcement to emergency management and community partners. Deputy Chief Moore's perspective will provide the public with clear, practical insights into how Los Angeles prepares for, manages, and supports safe evacuations during wildfire emergencies.
4. **REPORT ON THE BOARD OF FORESTRY:** The Board of Forestry is visiting Los Angeles to finalize the requirements for Zone 0. We will provide an update for anyone who did not attend the BoF meeting in Altadena, California.
