CAN LOS ANGELES ACTUALLY RECOVER FROM WILDFIRES?

MySafe:LA, the Regional Fire Safe Council for Los Angeles County, will host a virtual meeting on wildfire preparedness on July 16, 2026. The meeting will begin at 7:00 PM (Pacific Time) and will conclude around 8:30 PM (Pacific Time). The Wildfire Advisory Board will lead the meeting, and the public is invited to attend.

This is your chance to learn about recent developments and the issues that have arisen, and to share your thoughts and opinions on the significance of a recovery plan that benefits the entire city, extending beyond the burn scars of any specific fire. Join us to hear from [Maryam Zar](#), Founder and President of the Palisades Recovery Coalition, and [David Barrett](#), Executive Director of MySafe:LA, on this important topic. Additional guests may also be invited to contribute to the discussion.
5. **What is MySafe:LA doing to support additional recovery and resilience?** MySafe:LA will host a series of [community workshops](#) and is set to publish [a new recovery guide](#) for individuals in their “year two” after experiencing a wildfire. Additionally, they are preparing a guide focused on the development, ethics, and [management of Fire Safe Councils](#). These resources are intended to be effective and useful, regardless of where you live and work. Furthermore, [a new recovery survey](#) will be launched this week to collect essential data that may assist those affected by the wildfire disasters in Los Angeles County in January 2025.
